Children in Kindergarten to 6<sup>th</sup> grade is encouraged to create and submit a poster on one of the following topics by April 30, 2018:

1. What is public health?
2. What does public health do for you?

Judging Criteria: • Content accuracy • Visual communication of topic • Originality Artwork

Requirements: • Be original • Must not have student's name on the front • Should include a title on the front • White paper – 12 x 18 and 8.5 x 11 sizes are preferred, but all submission sizes will be accepted (preferred size eases reproducibility) • Can be created with crayon, markers, paint (watercolor, tempera, acrylic), collage, photographs or computer graphics. Lettering and message should be large enough to read at a distance, with all pencil markings erased • Copyrighted characters (such as Snoopy), product logos and trademarked or brand names cannot be used

Four posters will be selected from those entered from Lincoln, Logan, Thomas, Arthur, Hooker, and McPherson counties. Prizes donated from Wal-Mart D.C. 7018!!
